CONCOURS ORGANIZER MAKES TOP 50 PLAYERS LIST

International Publication Announces Who's Who In Classic Auto World

JACKSONVILLE, FL; July 12, 2007 --- UK-based *Octane* Magazine, one of Europe's top automotive publications, named in its August 2008 issue Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance organizer Bill Warner as one of its "Top 50 Players in the Classic Car World." Warner joins an impressive list of individuals, which includes Sir Stirling Moss, Derek Bell MBE, GM Vice Chairman Bob Lutz, America's first Formula One champion Phil Hill, TV personality Jay Leno, Miles Collier, Dan Gurney, Carroll Shelby, Pink Floyd drummer Nick Mason, and Lord March.

"That is a very encompassing list, and I have a lot of respect for all of the individuals on it; many of them are my personal heroes like Dan Gurney and Phil Hill. Each personality was asked three questions: what was your first car; what is the fastest car you have driven or have been driven in; and what is your absolute favorite car? Warner's replies: a 1961 Buick LeSabre, two-door hardtop; 180 mph at Daytona; and a 250GT SWB Ferrari Berlinetta. Octane compiled the list to celebrate its 50th issue.
